Learning objective: To solve addition, subtraction, money, and pattern problems within the context of Halloween.

1. 1. Max collected 7 orange pumpkins and 8 black cauldrons. How many items does he have in total? A) 13, B) 14, C) 15*, D) 16 (1 mark)

2. 2. True or False: If a bag of ghost sweets costs 30p and you pay with a 50p coin, your change is 20p. (1 mark)

3. 3. A spider has 8 legs. How many legs do 5 spiders have altogether? (1 mark)

4. 4. Zara the zebra has 20 spooky masks. She gives 8 away to her friends. How many masks does she have left? (1 mark)

5. 5. Which number comes next in this pattern? 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16, ? A) 17, B) 18*, C) 19, D) 20 (1 mark)

6. 6. True or False: £1 is the same as 100p. (1 mark)

7. 7. A magic potion kit costs £5. If you have £3, how much more money do you need to buy it? (1 mark)

8. 8. Pip the caterpillar ate 9 blackberries and 6 raspberries. How many berries did Pip eat? (1 mark)

9. 9. Kit the fox has 15 spooky stickers. He loses 4 of them. How many stickers are left? A) 9, B) 10, C) 11*, D) 12 (1 mark)

10. 10. True or False: $25 + 5$ is equal to 35. (1 mark)
