5. 5. True or False: 50p is more than £1. (1 mark)

6. 6. If a table is 2 metres long, how many centimetres is that? (1 mark)

7. 7. Max buys a banana for 50p and an apple for £1.00. How much does he spend in total? (1 mark)

8. 8. Which unit is best for measuring a heavy bag of potatoes? A) grams B) centimetres C) kilograms* D) millimetres (1 mark)

9. 9. True or False: There are 100 pence in £1. (1 mark)

10. 10. Max has 80p. He spends 30p on a sticker. How much money does he have left? (1 mark)
