

Max's Time-Keeping Challenge

Learning objective: To read, write and convert time between analogue and digital 12-hour clocks.

Max the monkey is organising his fruit store. Help him track the time for his deliveries. Use the clocks to help you answer the questions. Start your sentences with the words provided.

Word bank: analogue · digital · hour · minute · past · to · o'clock

1. Max starts his shift at 8:00 am. Draw the hands on an analogue clock face to show this time. What time is it? (2 marks)

2. The delivery truck arrives at 10:15. If the clock is digital, how would this time look? Write it in the box. (2 marks)

3. Max finishes counting apples at 3:30. How many minutes are in one hour? (Sentence starter: There are...) (2 marks)

4. The store closes at 5:45. Write this time in words. (Sentence starter: The time is...) (2 marks)

5. If it is 12:00, is it midday or midnight? Circle one. (1 mark)

Draw: Draw two clock faces. On the first clock, draw the hands to show 4 o'clock. On the second clock, draw the hands to show half past 2.

Extension challenge: Max has a break for 30 minutes. If his break starts at 1:00, what time does it finish? Write the time as a digital clock.
