

Kindness Around Us

Learning objective: To identify and illustrate acts of kindness within our school and community.

Follow the steps below to create your kindness poster. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing.

Draw: Draw a bright, colorful scene in the center of your paper. Show two characters (like Pip the caterpillar or a friend) doing something kind together, such as sharing a book, helping someone stand up, or listening to a story. Use warm colors like yellow and orange to show happiness. Include speech bubbles for your characters.



Label words: Help · Smile · Share · Listen · Friend · Support

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a scene showing someone being kind. Who is being kind? (e.g., 'Pip the caterpillar is...')
2. Step 2: Draw an item that shows sharing. What are they sharing?
3. Step 3: Label your drawing using two words from the word bank.
4. Step 4: Write one sentence about how kindness makes a friend feel.
