

Kindness at the Garden Party

Learning objective: To understand and demonstrate acts of kindness towards friends and peers within an Pre-K setting.

Look at the scene below. Use your pencils to add details of kindness, then answer the questions to show how you would be a kind friend.

Draw: Draw a sunny garden scene featuring Max the monkey sitting on a picnic blanket. Include space for at least two other friends to join him. Use bright colors and draw expressive, happy faces on all characters. Add items like a shared basket of fruit, a toy, or a book to show the characters playing together nicely.



Label words: sharing · helping · smiling · caring · friend · kindness

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a fruit to share between Max the monkey and his friend. What fruit did you choose?
2. Step 2: Draw a way to help your friend if they fall over. What could you say to them?
3. Step 3: If you had £2, what kind gift could you buy for a friend to make them smile?
4. Step 4: Label your drawing using one word from the word bank.
5. Step 5: Why is it important to show kindness to our friends?
