

Understanding Change: Growing Up

Learning objective: To understand the physical and emotional changes that occur during puberty and how to manage them with confidence and hygiene.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you with your answers. Write clearly and show your thinking.

Puberty is a natural process that happens to everyone as they transition from childhood to adulthood. During this time, the body changes physically, and feelings can often shift quickly. It is a time of growth, learning, and developing more independence. Taking care of your body through good hygiene habits becomes especially important during these years.

3. Why is personal hygiene, such as showering daily and using deodorant, important during puberty? (3 marks)

4. Explain how hormones can affect a person's emotions. How might someone manage these changing feelings? (4 marks)

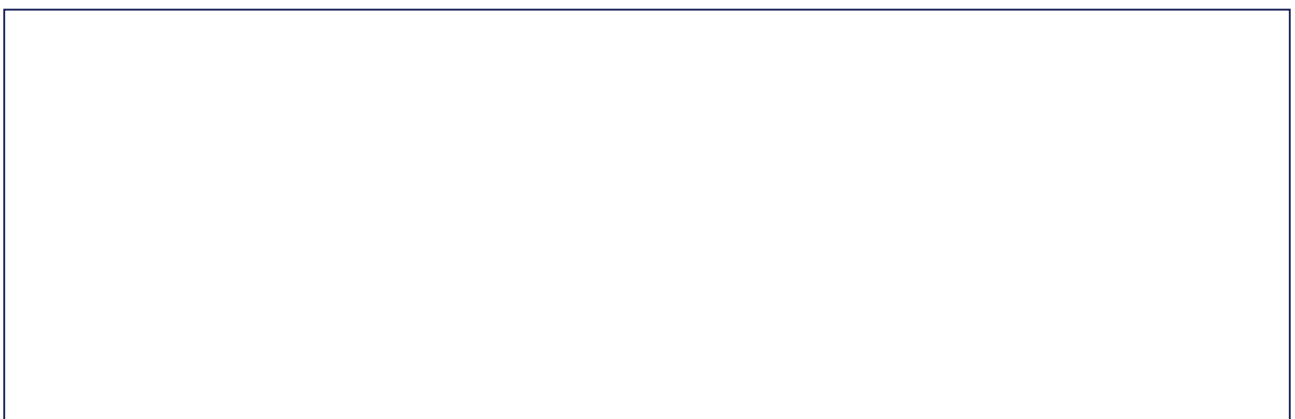
