

My Friendship Fact-File: All About My Friend

Learning objective: To identify and describe the qualities that make a good friend and understand how to build positive relationships.

Today, we are going to celebrate our friends! Choose a friend in your class or a family member. Use this template to fill in facts about why they are special to you. You can ask an adult to help you write your ideas down, or draw a picture of a time you shared a kind moment together.

Word bank: kind · sharing · helpful · funny · gentle · listening · smiling · playing · caring · brave

1. My Friend's Name: Write the name of your friend and draw a quick sketch of their favorite color or hobby.

2. Kindness Hero: What is one kind thing your friend does? (For example: Do they share their toys? Do they help you when you are sad?)

3. Playing Together: What is your favorite game to play with this friend? How do you make sure everyone has a turn?

4. Listening Ears: How do you show your friend that you are listening to them when they talk to you?

5. A Special Gift: If you had £1 to spend at the school fair, what small treat would you buy to share with your friend and why?

Extension challenge: Ask your friend what their favorite thing about being your friend is! Write down their answer at the bottom of your page.
