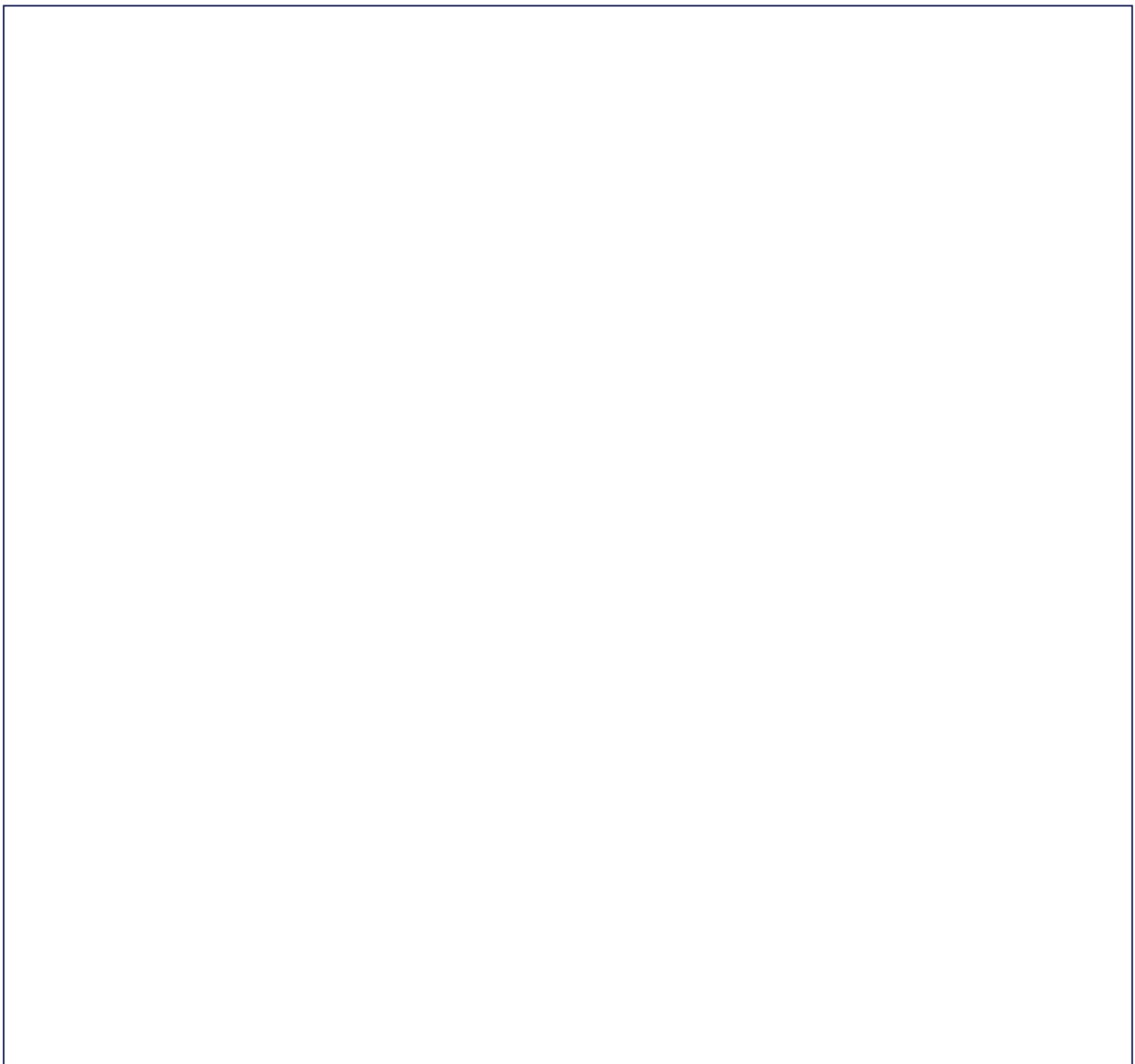


Leo's Big Climb: A Lesson in Resilience

Learning objective: To understand that resilience means trying again even when things feel difficult or when we make a mistake.

Talk to your child about how Leo the Lion is feeling. Ask them to color in the scene and think about a time they kept trying until they succeeded. Use bright colors to show how proud Leo feels when he reaches the top!

Colour this: A large, friendly-looking lion named Leo standing at the bottom of a gentle, grassy hill. Leo has a small, determined smile on his face. Halfway up the hill, there is a small patch of colorful flowers. At the top of the hill, there is a bright, smiling sun with rays. The drawing should feature thick, clear outlines suitable for a 3-5 year old. Include a small signpost near Leo that has a star drawn on it to represent his goal.



Steps:

1. Label the brave lion in the picture.
2. Label the big hill that Leo is climbing.
