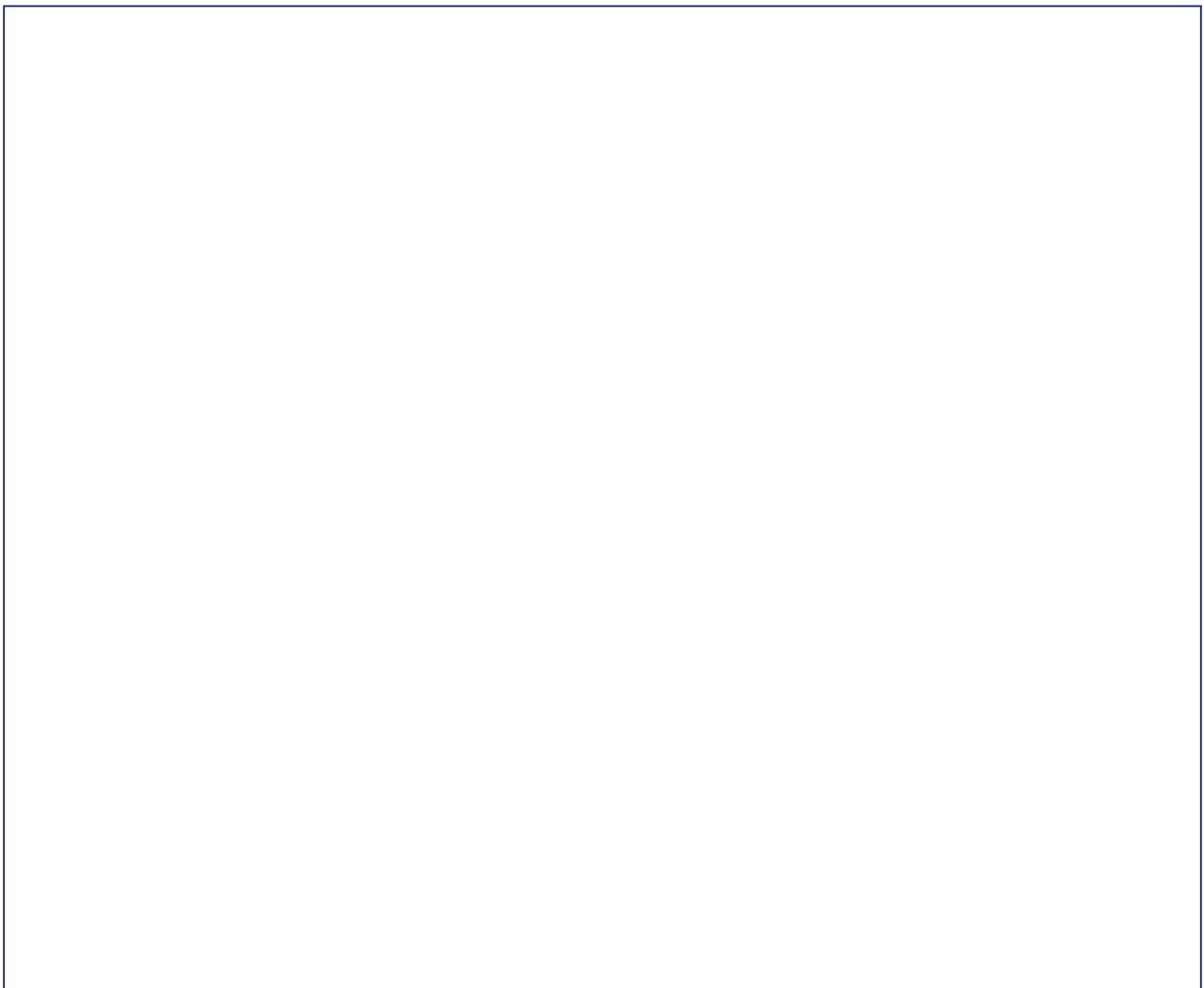


Leo's Big Try-Again Adventure

Learning objective: To understand the meaning of resilience by identifying how to keep trying when faced with a challenge.

Look at the drawing box below. Leo the Lion is trying to build a tall tower of wooden blocks, but it keeps wobbling and falling down! Think about what Leo can do to stay positive and keep trying. Draw Leo's next step, then answer the questions to show how you can be resilient too.

Draw: In the large box provided, draw a scene featuring Leo the Lion. On the left side, show a pile of scattered wooden blocks on the floor. On the right side, show Leo taking a deep breath and starting to stack the blocks again carefully. Use bright, cheerful colors. Style: Simple, clean lines suitable for a 3-5 year old's interpretation, with plenty of space to add details like a happy sun or encouraging friends nearby.



Label words: brave · try again · smile · proud · help · keep going

Steps:

1. Leo's tower fell over. How is Leo feeling? Draw a face on Leo in your picture to show his emotion.
2. What is one thing you can say to yourself if you find something hard to do?
3. Who could you ask for help if you were feeling stuck with a puzzle?
4. How do you feel when you finally finish something that was difficult?

5. Draw a star next to your drawing to show you are proud of your hard work!
