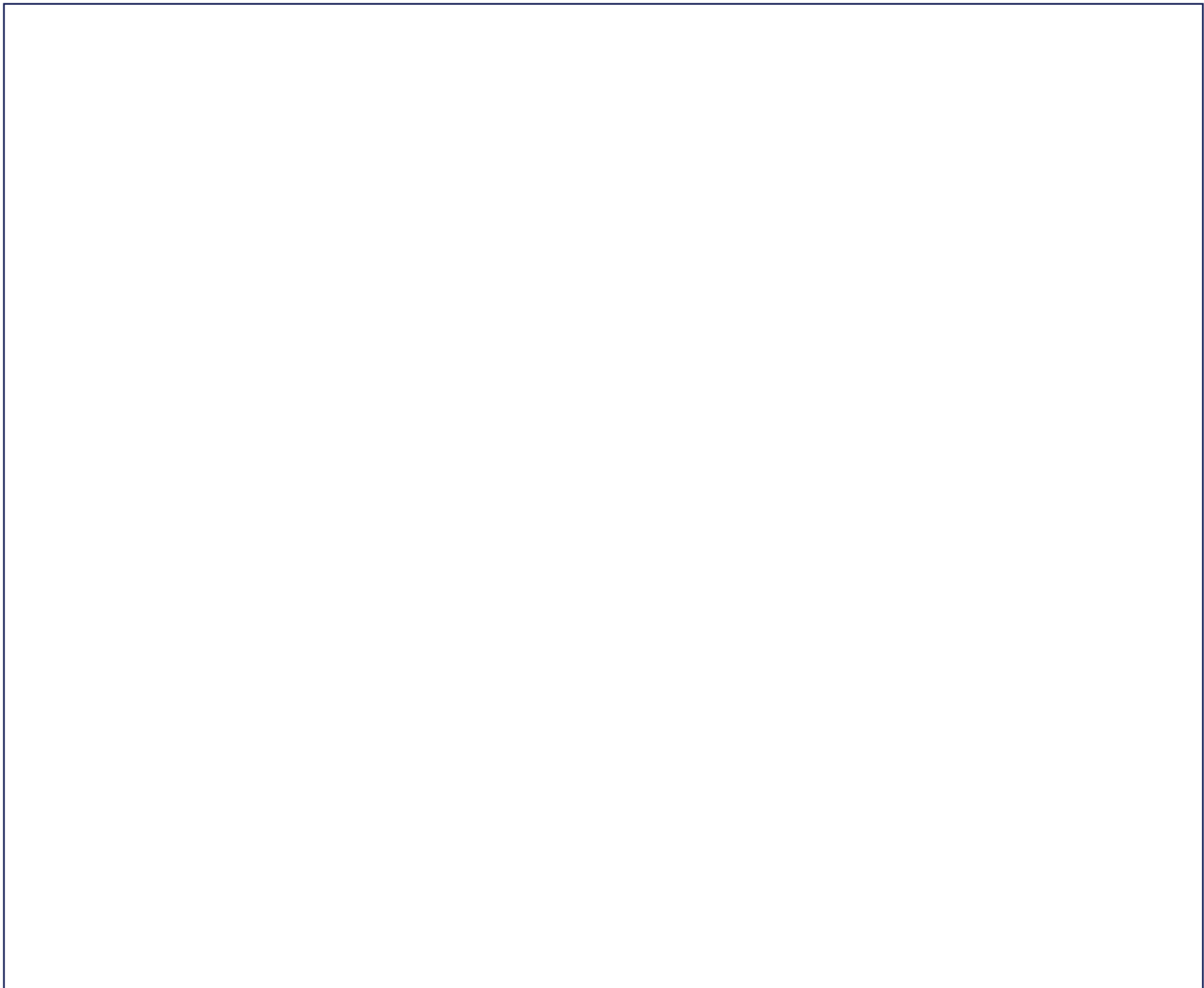


Bonfire Night with Nova and Leo

Learning objective: To identify and illustrate key symbols and safety features associated with Bonfire Night.

Follow the steps below to draw a Bonfire Night scene with Nova the owl and Leo the lion. Use your best artistic skills to add detail to your drawing.

Draw: Create a landscape scene at night. The bonfire should be the brightest part of the drawing, using oranges, reds, and yellows. The sky should be dark blue or black to help the fireworks stand out. Draw Nova the owl with wide eyes looking at the sky. Include Leo the lion sitting on a grassy patch at a safe distance from the fire. Use bright, shimmering colors for the fireworks and the sparkler.



Label words: bonfire · sparkler · firework · glow · night sky · safety

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large bonfire in the middle of your page. Draw Leo the lion sitting a long way back from the fire to stay safe. Label the bonfire.
2. Step 2: Draw Nova the owl flying above. Draw bright, colorful fireworks in the night sky. Label the fireworks.
3. Step 3: Draw a sparkler in someone's hand (make sure they are wearing gloves). Label the sparkler.
4. Step 4: Think of one safety rule for Bonfire Night and write it in a speech bubble near Leo.
