

Easter Time with Max and Zara

Learning objective: To identify and illustrate symbols associated with the festival of Easter and explain their meanings.

Follow the steps below to create your Easter scene. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing. Max and Zara are helping you today!

Draw: Create a colorful scene on a plain white background. In the center, draw a large, decorated Easter egg with bright patterns. Around the egg, draw colorful spring flowers like daffodils or tulips. In the top corner, draw a simple wooden cross. Add a small, glowing candle next to the cross to represent light. Use bright colors like yellow, green, and purple to show that spring has arrived.



Label words: Cross · Egg · Spring flowers · New life · Hope · Candle

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large egg in the middle of your page. Why do people think an egg is a symbol of new life? Write one sentence.
2. Step 2: Draw some spring flowers next to your egg. What do these flowers tell us about the season of spring?
3. Step 3: Draw a cross in the corner. Why is the cross important to Christians at Easter?

4. Step 4: Label your drawing using at least three words from the word bank.
