

Learning About Judaism with Ellie

Learning objective: To identify and label key objects found in a Jewish home or synagogue that show how Jewish people express their faith.

Follow the steps below to complete your drawing. Use the word bank to help you label your work.

Draw: Draw a scene inside a room. On the right, draw a doorframe with a small rectangle (Mezuzah) attached to the side. On a table, draw a Menorah with nine branches. Near the back, draw a scroll inside a decorative case to represent the Torah. You may draw a person wearing a small circular cap called a Kippah. Use bright colors and clear lines.



Label words: Mezuzah · Menorah · Torah · Kippah

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a small box on the doorpost of a house. This is a Mezuzah. What is its purpose?
2. Step 2: Draw a candle holder with nine branches. This is a Menorah. Why is it used?
3. Step 3: Draw a scroll which holds the sacred text. This is the Torah. Where is it usually kept?
4. Step 4: Label your drawing using the words from the word bank.
