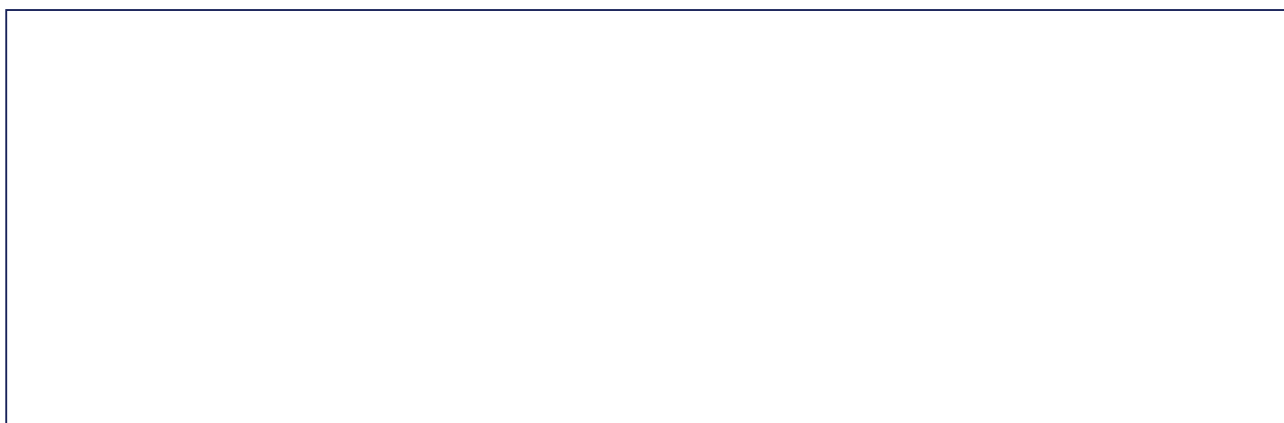
3. 3. What is the name of the special day of rest that starts on Friday evening? (1 mark)
