Learning objective: To understand why we celebrate Remembrance Day and the meaning behind symbols like the poppy.

Word bank: Poppy · Peace · November · Respect · Soldiers

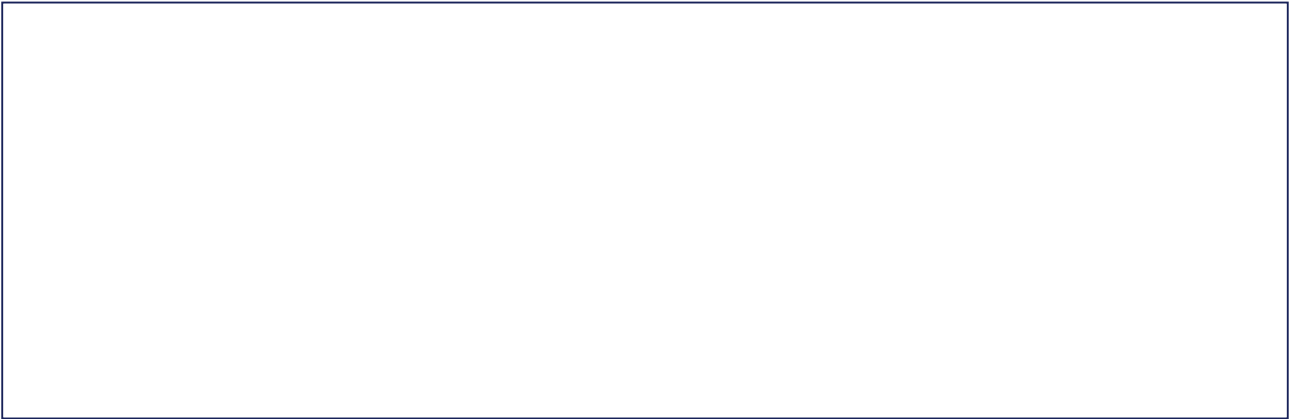
1. True or False: Remembrance Day happens in July. (If false, write the correct month below.) (2 marks)

2. True or False: The red flower used as a symbol is a rose. (If false, write the correct flower name.) (2 marks)

3. True or False: We wear a symbol to show respect for the people who helped us. (Explain why we show respect.) (2 marks)

4. True or False: Remembrance Day is a time to think about peace. (What does peace mean to you?) (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a bright red poppy in the space below. You could add a green stem and a black center.
