

Nova's Fall Discovery Hunt

Learning objective: To identify and describe the changes that happen to plants and trees during the fall season.

Nova the owl is watching the forest change. Look at the list of changes below. Decide if each one happens in fall or in summer. Draw a line to connect the change to the correct season.

1. Match the description to the season:

Warm sun — [Season]

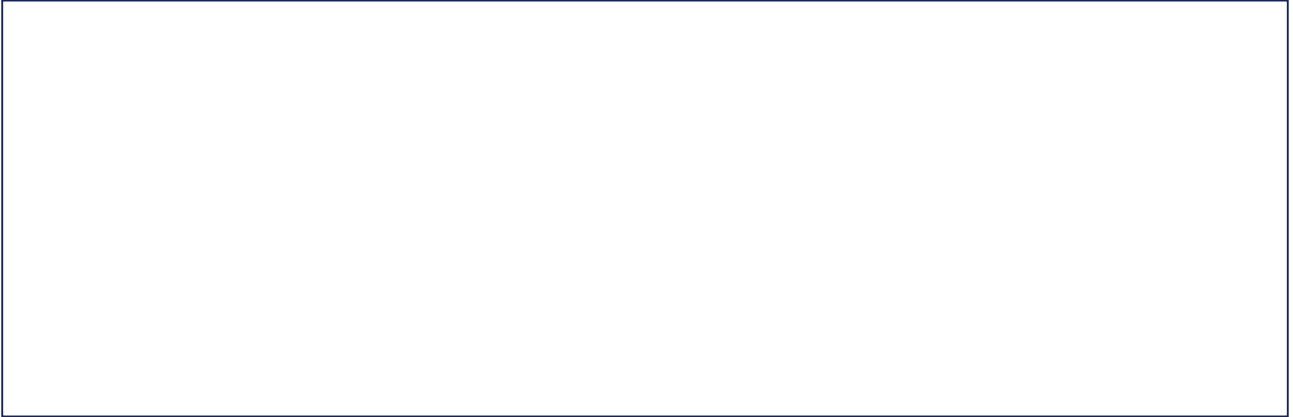
Cool air — [Season] (4 marks)

3. List two things you might see on the ground in fall. (2 marks)

4. Is the weather in fall usually wetter or drier than in summer? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of an fall tree. Use your crayons to color the leaves in shades of red, orange, and gold.



Extension challenge: Go outside with an adult. Collect three different types of leaves. Can you name the tree they came from?
