

Nova's Fall Nature Watch

Learning objective: To observe and describe the changes in plants and animals during the fall season.

Hello! Nova the owl is exploring the woods to see how the season is changing. Use this sheet to record what you see outside. Look at the trees, the ground, and the animals. Use the word bank to help you write your sentences.

Word bank: deciduous · evergreen · hibernate · migrate · crisp · golden · temperature · scavenge

1. Tree Watch: Find a tree. What color are the leaves? Are they falling off? Describe what the tree looks like. (2 marks)

2. Weather Report: Is the air warm or cold? How does it feel when you go outside today? (2 marks)

3. Animal Spotting: Can you see any animals or insects? What are they doing to get ready for winter? (2 marks)

4. My Discovery: Write one interesting fact about fall that you found today. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you collect three different colored leaves and stick them in your book? Label them with the tree name if you know it!
