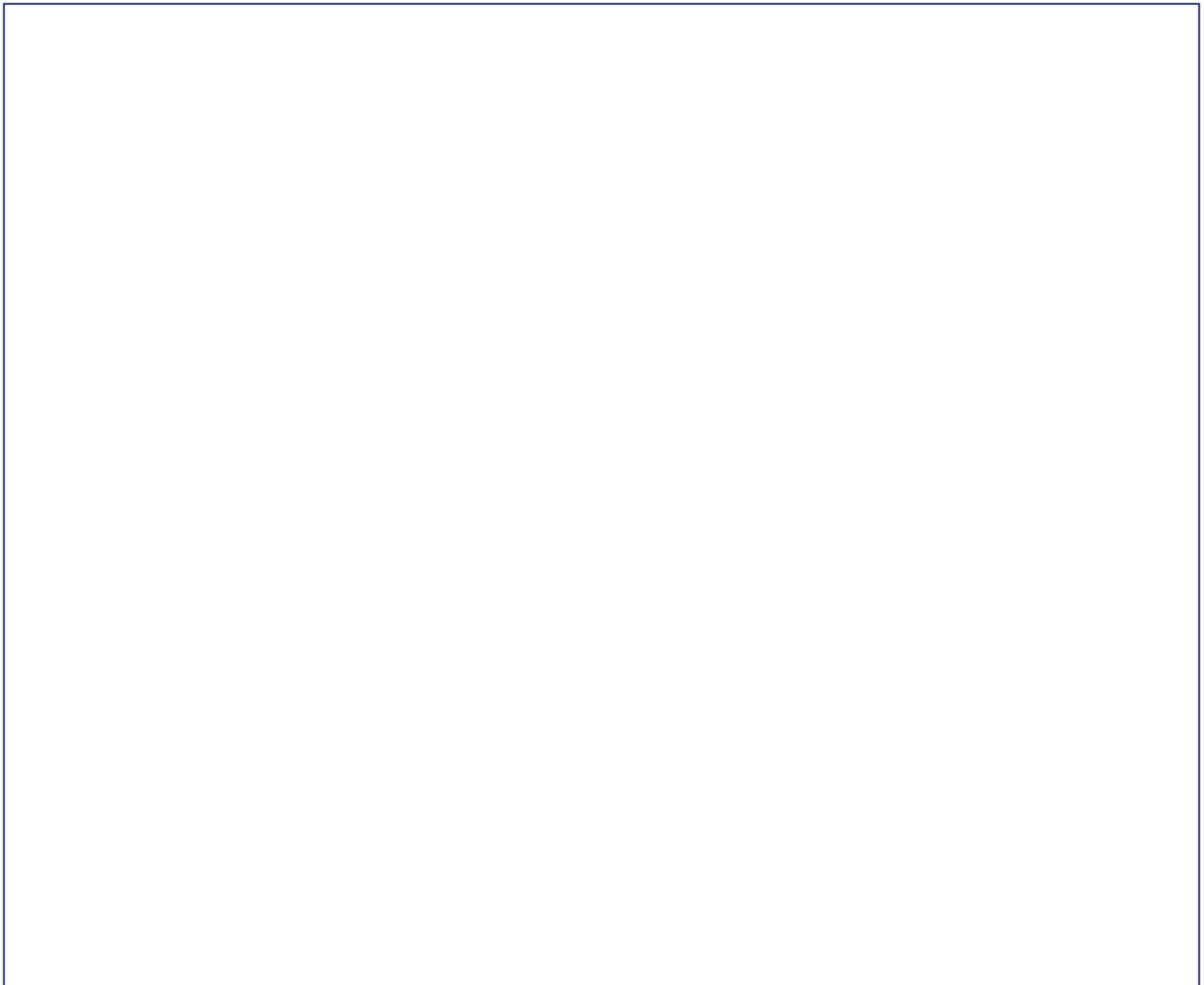


Fall Nature Journal with Nova the Owl

Learning objective: To observe and identify the seasonal changes associated with fall.

Help Nova the Owl prepare for the changing seasons! Use your pencils and crayons to complete the fall scene. Look at the word bank to help you label the parts of your drawing.

Draw: Create a peaceful fall woodland scene. In the center, draw a large, wide tree with some leaves still attached (in shades of red, orange, and yellow) and many leaves scattered on the ground below. Draw Nova the owl perched on a branch, looking down curiously. Add details like fallen conkers in their spiky cases and a few acorns on the forest floor. Use a warm, autumnal color palette for the background.



Label words: acorn · conker · orange leaf · brown leaf · Nova the owl · tree

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large tree in the middle of your page. What color do the leaves turn in fall?
2. Step 2: Draw Nova the owl sitting on a branch. Does Nova have feathers or fur?
3. Step 3: Draw two fallen leaves on the ground. Are the leaves smooth or crunchy?
4. Step 4: Draw a small acorn on the grass. Which animal likes to hide acorns for the winter?
5. Step 5: Label your drawing using the words from the word bank.
