Follow the path of energy from the bright sun to the buzzing bees!

- A producer is a plant that makes its own food using sunlight.
- A consumer is an animal that eats plants or other animals.
- The prey is the animal that gets hunted for food.
- The predator is the animal that hunts other animals.
- Arrows in a food chain show the direction the energy moves.

Did you know? Did you know? Almost all energy in a food chain starts with the Sun! Plants take the sunlight and turn it into food. Animals then eat the plants to get that energy to grow and play.
