

Bea's Garden Habitats

Learning objective: To identify and label the features of a living thing and its habitat.

Follow the steps below to draw a garden scene. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing clearly.

Draw: Create a simple, colorful garden scene. Draw one large flower with clearly visible roots, a stem, leaves, and wide petals. Draw a bright yellow sun in the top corner. Draw Bea the honeybee flying near the flower. Use bright colors to make your garden look healthy and happy.



Label words: petals · stem · roots · leaves · soil · sunlight

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a tall flower in the middle of your page. Label the parts using the words in the bank.
2. Step 2: Draw the soil at the bottom of the flower. What does the flower need from the soil?
3. Step 3: Draw a bright sun in the corner. Why does the flower need sunlight?
4. Step 4: Draw Bea the bee visiting the flower. What part of the flower does the bee land on?
