6. 6. True or False: A deciduous tree keeps its green leaves all year round. (1 mark)

7. 7. Which tree stays green even in winter? A) Oak, B) Horse Chestnut, C) Holly* (1 mark)

8. 8. Which part of the plant holds the flower up towards the sun? (One word answer) (1 mark)

9. 9. True or False: A dandelion is a common wild plant. (1 mark)

10. 10. Seeds are usually planted in this to help them grow. What is it? (1 mark)
