

Nova's Seasonal Sorting Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and describe the four seasons and their associated weather and environmental changes.

Nova the owl has been watching the trees and the weather all year long! Look at the list of clues below. Decide which season each clue belongs to and write the correct season in the box next to it. Some clues might happen in more than one season, so think carefully about when you see them most!

Word bank: Spring · Summer · Fall · Winter

1. The weather is very hot and the sun stays out for a long time. Children wear sun hats and play in the park. (1 mark)

2. Leaves turn brown, orange, and red, and then fall off the trees. (1 mark)

3. New buds appear on the trees and baby animals are born. It starts to get warmer. (1 mark)

4. It is often very cold and there might be frost or snow on the ground. (1 mark)

5. Which season is your favorite? Explain why using one thing you like to do during that time. (2 marks)

Draw: In the boxes below, draw one thing you would wear in Winter and one thing you would wear in Summer.

Extension challenge: Nova wants to know what happens to the day length as we move from Summer to Winter. Ask a grown-up to help you find out if the days get longer or shorter as we head towards December.
