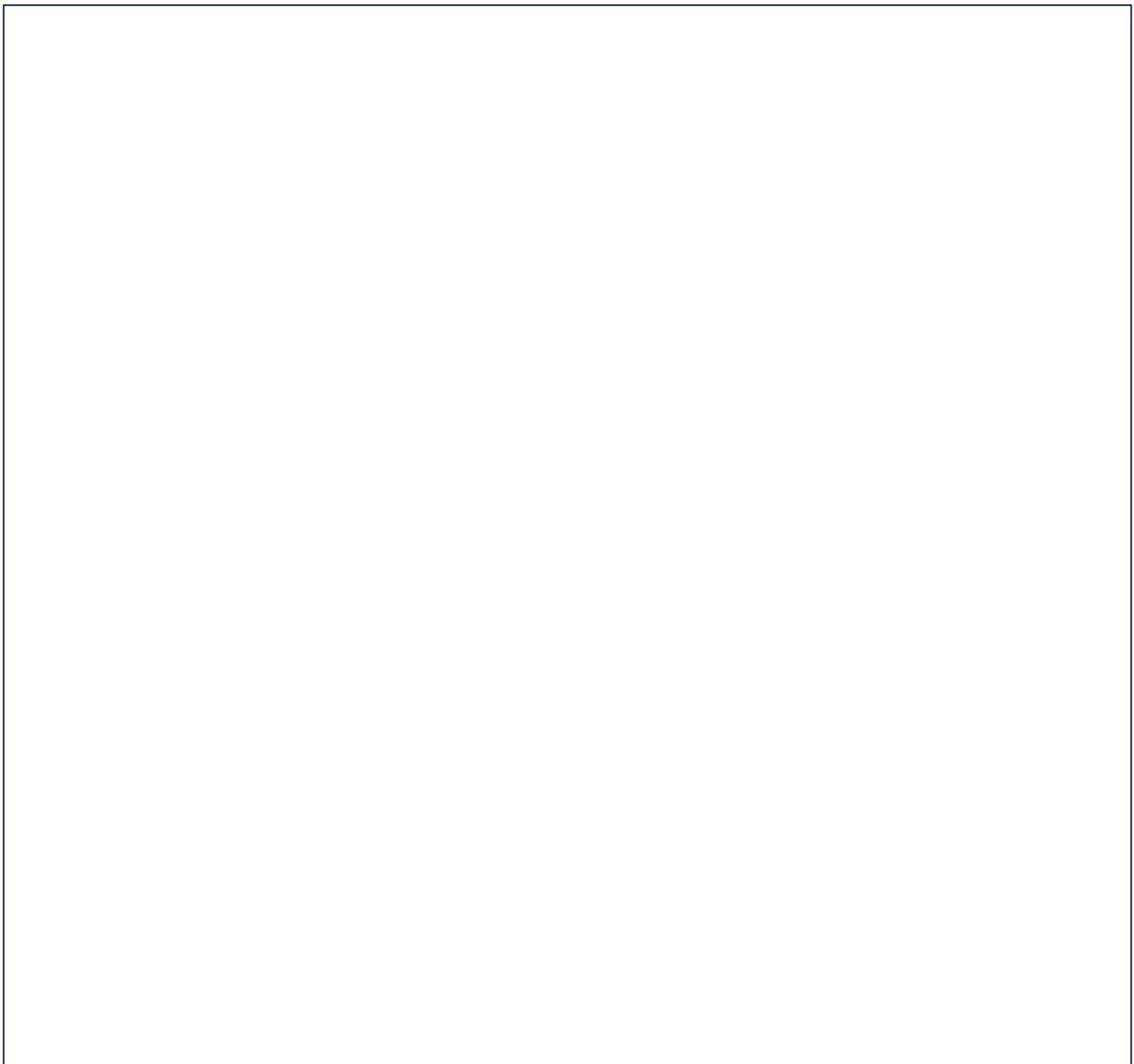


Nova's Seasonal Garden

Learning objective: To observe and describe weather associated with the four seasons.

Look at the picture of Nova the owl's garden. Color each section to show how the tree changes through the year. Read the facts about the seasons below.

Colour this: A large, central oak tree divided into four vertical sections, one for each season. Section 1 (Spring): New green buds and small colorful flowers. Section 2 (Summer): Full, bright green leaves and a bright sun in the sky. Section 3 (Fall): Orange and brown leaves falling to the ground. Section 4 (Winter): Bare branches with white, fluffy snow resting on them. Nova the owl is perched on a middle branch, wearing a small scarf. The background shows a simple horizon line.



Steps:

1. Label the season where the tree has white snow on its branches.
2. Label the season where the tree has new, green buds and flowers.
