

Springtime Science with Bea the Bee

Learning objective: To identify and label the parts of a plant and understand how they grow in Spring.

Follow the steps below to draw your Spring garden. Use the word bank to help you label the parts of your flower.

Draw: Draw a bright, colorful Spring garden scene. In the center, draw a tall, healthy flower with roots in the soil, a stem, green leaves, and a small flower bud waiting to open. Use bright colors for the petals to attract Bea the Bee. Draw in a clear, simple style with plenty of space to write your labels.



Label words: Root · Stem · Leaf · Petal · Bud

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large, colorful flower in the middle of your page. Draw a circle for the center and five petals around it.
2. Step 2: Draw a long, green stem coming down from the flower. Add two leaves to the side of the stem.
3. Step 3: Draw the roots at the bottom of the stem, hidden under a line of brown soil.
4. Step 4: Draw a small, closed bud next to your big flower. Label the parts of the plant using the words from the word bank.
